When coming back from the fields, wear a mask, wash your hands, use hand sanitizer, and wash worker's clothes separately.



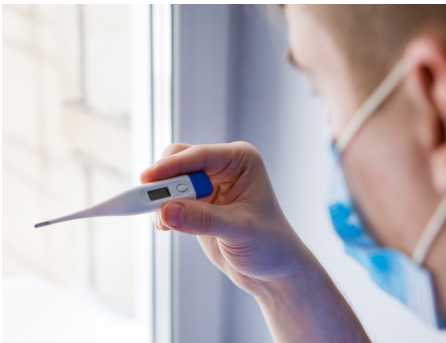
Clean and Safe Household

People should stay at least 6 feet apart in shared areas. Don't share your tools and utensils. Keep all frequently touched surfaces clean.



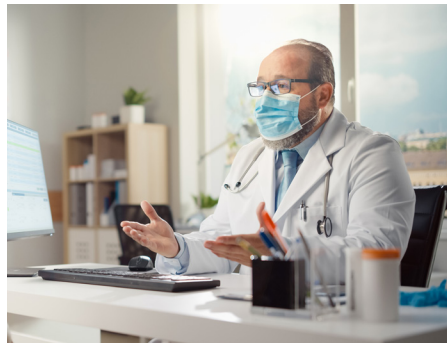
People at High Risk

If you or anyone else in your household is at high risk (older adults and people with illnesses), you should take [additional physical distancing and hygiene precautions](#).



If Anyone Is Sick

If you or anyone else in your household has symptoms of COVID-19, they should isolate and not use shared areas. Everyone in the household should wear masks.



Medical Assistance

Ask your health care provider about treatment for COVID-19 and how to get a vaccine.



Get Vaccinated

COVID-19 vaccines are safe. Everyone should get vaccinated to protect ourselves, our families, and friends.
